

2000 Richard Partridge Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley

Varietal Composition: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon; from the Sacrashe and Stanton Vineyards.

Winemaking: The 2000 vintage easily withstood over a month of extended maceration which added additional depth and complexity to the wine. After fermentation, the wine was aged for 20 months in a combination of new and 2 year old Sequin Moreau, Demptos Allier and Troncais Oak. Bottled unfinned and unfiltered.

Winemaker Bob Egelhoff's Tasting Notes: Dark, reddish ruby. Alluring aromas of blackberry and black cherry with hints of cocoa powder, anise, and spicy vanilla. These aromas coalesce with the rich, full-bodied dark cherry and plum flavors that climax with a long, elegant finish.
