WINEMAKING NOTES: Grapes from the Sacrashe and Stanton Vineyards were barrel fermented in sixty gallon French Oak barrels for 21 months.

TASTING NOTES: Inky, magenta color. Dark, rich, young and fairly muscular, this wine is loaded with cinnamon, spice and black cherry fruits. Upon tasting, these aromas become dominant flavors and combine with cherry cola and black cherry to bring out the pedigree of this wine. Powerful ripe tannins and hints of sweet oak add to the age worthiness of this wine.
